

**Title**

Grade Kindergarten-6 Sunday School Teacher

**Purpose**

To teach the truths of God's Word so children will come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ and grow in their commitment to Him.

**Qualifications**

- Attended East White Oak Bible Church for at least 6 months
- A Christian living a Christ honoring life
- Successful completion of the volunteer application process
- A love for children and a desire to see them grow spiritually
- Committed to consistently abide by the Children's Ministry policies

**Term of Service**

One year (September through May)

**Responsibilities**

- Enthusiastically, creatively, and accurately (to Biblical truths) teach the curriculum provided to you by the Director of Children's Ministries
- Pray for your students, other children's ministry staff members, and the Director of Children's Ministries
- Spend time during the week in lesson preparation
- Be in your classroom at least 15 minutes early to assure safety of children who arrive early
- Provide a warm, friendly greeting to each child
- Commit to developing friendships with the children in your class
- Make your classroom as physically appealing and spiritually challenging as possible using posters, charts, bulletin boards, etc.
- Attend teacher training sessions when offered by the church
- When unable to be present to teach your class, call one of the approved substitutes and notify the Director of Children's Ministries of the change
- Other suggested activities might include:
  - Attend children's ministry conferences, conventions, and/or seminars
  - Contact students by written correspondence or phone

**Relationships**

- Elementary teachers are appointed by the Senior Associate Pastor after being approved by the board of Elders
- Ongoing supervision of elementary teachers is provided by the Director of Children's Ministries
