Nursery Caregiver

**Purpose**

To meet the physical needs of the infants and toddlers with loving warmth. To provide a clean, safe, efficient, and friendly service to the parents and children. To minister to the parents by providing encouragement and support.

**Qualifications**

- Attended East White Oak Bible Church for at least 6 months
- A growing relationship with Christ
- A love and concern for infants/toddlers, and an ability to care for their well-being
- Ability to relate well to parents and nursery workers
- Availability to work one Sunday a month in the nursery
- Successful completion of the volunteer application process
- Committed to consistently abide by the Children's Ministry policies

**Term of Service**

One year

**Responsibilities**

- Arrive in the nursery 15 minutes before the service is to begin (i.e. 8:45 for 9:00 am service and 10:15 for the 10:30 am service)
- Love and play with the children
- Comfort children who are crying
- Help with snacks/feedings, changing diapers, meeting the basic needs of infants and/or toddlers in your care
- When you cannot be present, call a substitute or another nursery caregiver to trade Sundays
