• Ministry Focus

Dr. Rochunga Pudaite founded Bibles for the World in 1971.

From a tribal home in N.E. India to being educated in England and the U.S., Ro had a heart for translating the Bible into his native language. Once he accomplished that, Ro and his wife Mawii saw the need for educating their people and now have 45 local schools, 5 high schools and Trinity College & Seminary (1998). Church planting came next, and now the desire is to send missionaries from Manipur throughout India with the Gospel. Dr. Ro's first donation for printing Bibles came from EWO on one of his many visits here.

• Ministry Focus

From the beginning of their marriage, Lucas and Jamie realized that ministering in another culture was part of God's plan for them. On a short-term trip in northern Siberia, God showed the couple the desperate need of over 15 people groups. More than 10,000 communities exist without a church. "It was this need—and certainly not the cold, winter weather—that brought us to Siberia." In 2007, InterAct Ministries asked the Orners to minister in the republic of Tuva (just north of Mongolia). Currently, the Orners (with son, Samuel) are in their first year in Russia, studying the language. Their ministry focuses on church planting among the Tuvan people through training local church leaders, discipleship, and evangelism.

• Prayer Requests

Language Study

- Pray for absorbent minds as they study Russian, and for opportunities to share their faith.

Ministry

- Pray for the publication of the newly translated Tuvan Bible, to be distributed 2010.
- Pray for the spiritual encouragement of the Tuvan church leaders, and for their continued motivation to minister in communities without a church.
- Pray for more workers to minister among unreached people groups.

Family

- Praise God for good health through their first Siberian winter. Please pray for continued good health.
- Receiving a visa to stay in Russia long-term can be difficult. Pray for open doors to a future ministry in Tuva.
